

### **Snyder County Conservation District 2016 Tree & Plant Sale**

The Snyder County Conservation District (SCCD) held another tree and plant sale in 2016. The pickup days were Thursday and Friday, April 14 and 15, at the Conservation District office, located at 10541 Route 522, Middleburg, PA.

Tree seedlings offered in 2015 included: Black Hill White Spruce, Norway Spruce and Red Oak. Three types of fruit trees were sold: Honey Crisp Apple, Sandra Rose Cherry and Johnboy Peach. We also sold Bohemian horseradish and hop rhizomes.

Also offered were a perennial wildflower mix, gourd seeds and ginseng seeds, Southern Magnolia, Fireball and KopperKing Hibiscuses, Burning Bush, blueberry plans, Paw Paw trees, rain barrels, bluebird boxes, soil test kits, tree planting bars and tree tube protectors. Fifty pound bags of sunflower seed for songbird feeding were sold as well.
