

Middle School Students Learn about Environment at Local Envirothon

Thirty-one (31) teams involving approximately 150 students from various schools in Union, Snyder, Northumberland, Montour and Columbia Counties participated at the annual Susquehanna Valley Middle School Envirothon on May 8, 2018. The event, geared towards 7th and 8th graders, is a combination outdoor learning experience and a friendly contest of environmental knowledge.

This year's Envirothon was held at the Montour Preserve near Danville and Washingtonville, PA. Participating students learned about and were tested on the following issues: wildlife, forestry, aquatics and soils.
