sweet and a favorite of honey-
bees. mature height 25—4040'

White Oak



3 yr seedlings 18-24"
10 for \$15
(bare root)
Develops notably strong
branches.
Can live for centuries.
Mature height 40'—100'

Eastern Red Bud



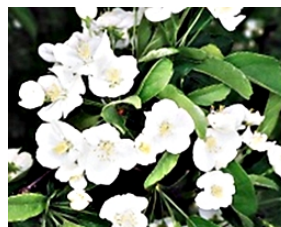
3 yr seedlings 2-3'
10 for \$12
(bare root)
Flowers are reddish purple in bud,
opening to a rosy pink with purplish
tinge in spring Mature height 20'-30'

Chinese Chestnut



12-18" seedlings
10 for \$15
Yields a ripened nut crop
September through October.
Mature Height— 40' - 60'

Sargent Crabapple



3 year seedlings
18-24" Seedlings
10 for \$10
A small, shrub-like tree fragrant
pure white flowers in mid May.
Mature Height— 8-10'

2 different apple trees with overlapping bloom time are required

Red Haven Peach

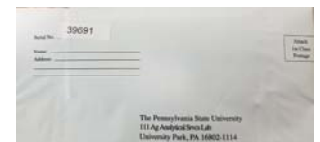


5/8" caliper Semi dwarf
