

Farmer's Winter Meeting Held near Selinsgrove

The Snyder County Conservation District (SCCD) its annual Farmer's Winter Meeting on Friday, February 16, 2018, at the Christ Community United Methodist Church, 3939 Park Road near Selinsgrove. One hundred two (102) people attended the meeting. Topics presented during the meeting include the following: Preventing fly problems due to manure, Proper mortality composting and Stress management, and Conservation District & U.S. Department of Agriculture updates. There was also information about safely using pesticides while protecting pollinators or preventing drift, proper site analysis and pest management updates.

Guest speakers came from USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), USDA-Farm Service Agency (FSA), PA Agricultural Ombudsman Program, Evangelical Community & Wellness, Penn State Department of Animal Science and Penn State Extension (PSE).
