Snyder County Conservation District Sells Trees, Seeds, Etc.

The Snyder County Conservation District held another tree sale in 2011. The pickup days were Thursday, April 14 and Friday, April 15, 2011 at the Conservation District office, located at 10541 Route 522, Middleburg, PA.

Tree seedlings offered in 2011 included: Concolor Fir, Douglas Fir, Norway Spruce, White Oak and American Arborvitae. Seedlings were three and four year old and most had stem diameter the size of a pencil or a little larger.

Also offered were two choices of wildflower seed mixes, Knock Out rose bushes, Lady Baltimore Hibiscus, rain barrels, bluebird boxes and tree tube protectors. We had four types of fruit trees: two apple varieties (Honey Crisp and Gala), one peach (Red Haven) and one cherry (Black Gold). New to the sale were blueberry plants.
