

Four-County Municipal Partners Workshop Held in Richfield

The Snyder County Conservation District, along with Mifflin County, Juniata County and Perry County Conservation Districts, held a workshop for local municipal leaders and officials on Wednesday, April 3, 2013, at the Village Merchants, 3473 Sand Valley Road, Richfield. Eighty-seven (87) people attended the workshop. Topics presented during the workshop included:

- NPDES (National Pollution Discharge Elimination System) permitting
- Update on PA Title 25, Chapter 102 erosion control regulations
- PA Title 25, Chapter 105 stream and wetland regulations
- Utilizing enzymes to stabilize dirt & gravel roads
- Stormwater easements
- Joint Federal and county emergency issues

Speakers came from PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), staff members from various county emergency management services (EMS) and a local dealer of dirt & gravel road enzyme sealers. Major sponsors also gave small presentations to the group. Meals were provided at \$5.00 per person.
