Snyder County Conservation District's Forestry Stewardship Planning Fact Sheet

The Snyder County Conservation District has recently had a forest stewardship plan developed for the Selinsgrove Center Grounds with financial assistance from the (DCNR) PA Department of Conservation & Natural Resources' Bureau of Forestry. DCNR manages the plan development cost share program. Funds to cover some of the plan development originate from the USDA (US Department of Agriculture) Forestry Service under the Forest Stewardship Program.

Alan Naylor, (below, right in photo holding sign with Craig Bingman, SCCD District Manager) Consulting Forester from Greenbar Forestry Services, developed the plan for SCCD. These stewardship plans assist landowners how to manage their forested land in ways that meets the owner's goals and helps out our environment.



Forest stewardship plans begin with a meeting between the consulting forester and the landowner. The consulting forester collects information on the property and makes recommendations on how to manage the land in the future to meet the landowner's goals. Plans generally written with recommendations for the landowner need to be re-evaluated every ten years.
