## POST-DISPOSITIONAL PROCEDURES

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

All juveniles and their counsel must review and sign this form if the juvenile has been adjudicated delinquent. The form must be reviewed, the juvenile must initial the first page and sign the last page, and the form must be presented to the Court immediately after disposition by the Court.

- 1. You have the right to file a post-dispositional motion. All requests for relief from the Court shall be stated with specificity and particularity and are to be consolidated in one (1) post-dispositional motion.
  - 2. A post-dispositional motion must be filed within ten (10) days of today's date.
- 3. The Court must decide the post-dispositional motion with thirty (30) days of the date that the post-dispositional motion is filed. Upon the request of a party the Court may grant one (1) thirty-day (30) extension for decision of that motion.

4. If the post-dispositional motion is not decided by the Court within thirty (30) days, or by the conclusion of the one (1) thirty-day (30) extension if it is granted, the post-dispositional motion will be deemed to be denied by operation of law.

5. If a post-dispositional motion is deemed to be denied by operation of law the Clerk of Courts shall enter an order on behalf of the Court denying the post-dispositional motion.

6. You have the right to file a written appeal to the Superior Court of Pennsylvania within thirty (30) days of today's date, or, if you file a post-dispositional motion, within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of the order deciding the post-dispositional motion.

7. You have the right to have an attorney prepare the motion and appeal, and pursue the motion and appeal, and if you cannot afford an attorney, an attorney will be provided to you at no cost to you.

8. All issues raised before and during adjudication shall be deemed to be preserved for appeal whether or not you elect to file a post-dispositional motion.
