

EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

FOR UNION AND SNYDER COUNTY RENTERS



Union and Snyder counties received a combined **\$5.6 million** for emergency rental assistance.


Union-Snyder Community Action Agency (CAA) is now processing applications to distribute this emergency funding for eligible residents.


Union and Snyder counties are offering financial assistance to residents with unpaid **rent** or **utility** bills due to the impact of **COVID-19**.

Eligibility Requirements Include:

- Eligible expenses include rent, utility, and home energy costs.
- Eligible households include those with reduced income or financial hardships that were directly or indirectly related to COVID-19.
