Norway Spruce

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * * *

- It has many uses including lumber, pulpwood, and landscaping trees.
- It's the fastest growing of the spruces.
- Can be planted on a wide variety of sites.
- Yields light brown 4-6" cones.
- Mature height: 50'

Eastern White Pine



- Fast-growing and hardy tree.
- A five needled pine, with soft, light green-blue needles, 4 inches long.
- Excellent ornamental tree for windbreak or dense screen.
- Mature height: 50-80'

American Persimmon

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * *



- Grown for its beautiful foliage, edible fruit and wood density.
- Leaves may turn orange or scarlet in autumn.
- Fruit is orange-yellow, sweet and edible once ripe after a hard freeze.
- Matures in mid to late fall.
- Mature height: 60'

White Oak



- The "Mighty Oak" has dense foliage is bluish-green, to reddish-brown in autumn .
- High resistance to ice breakage
- Is the best tree to plant to attract butterflies. It supports 934 caterpillar species throughout the nation!
- Mature Height: 50-80'

American Hazelnut

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * * *



- Also known as American Filbert
- Must plant two shrubs for pollination.
- Will bear nuts in 2-3 years.
- Hazelnut hedges can be used as windbreaks, visual screens, and to attract wildlife.
- Mature Height: 10' 15'

<u>American Beech</u>



- Provides golden bronze fall color
- Features simple leaves that are 3–6" long with sharp, incurved teeth on the margins
- Yields edible, hard, brown beechnuts that are ½-1" in diameter
- Mature Height: 50-70'

Chinese Chestnut

- Chinese chestnut is a medium size deciduous flowering tree
- Trees can start bearing the first nuts in 3-4 years.
- Prefers full sun to partial shade and moist well drained soil.
- Mature height: 40-60'

- Is a great, low cost alternative to the popular cultivars, and the wildlife love them.
- Fragrant apple blossoms will please local bee populations as they collect nectar and pollen.
- Mature height: 12-20'

Northen Pecan

- Pinnately compound leaves that turn a beautiful yellow color in the fall
- Can handle winter temperatures as low as -35 degrees F
- Northern pecan trees can start producing in as little as 6 years.
- Mature Height: 70'

Winterberry



- Beautiful fall and winter color.
- Female plants produce bright red berries for fall and winter.
- For best pollination plant at least five together.
- Berries attract winter song birds.
- Mature Height: 6-12'

* * * * * * * * * * * * * *



- Fruit is large, green-yellow apple with a red-orange blush, Shizuka has the same parentage as Mutsu, but its flavor is sweeter, and less tart.
- Slow to brown when cut.
- It ripens late August to mid-October.
- Semi Dwarf
- Mature Height: 15'- 20'

<u>Julyprince Peach</u>



- Consistently large peach. It averages between 3 and 4 inches in diameter
- Fruit is exquisitely scarlet red over yellow freestone firm peach
- Self pollinating you may still want to plant pollinating partners to increase the size of your crops
- Ripens in Early August.
- Mature Height: 15'- 20'

Grapes—Concord

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * *



- Grape is typically dark blue or purple
- Harvest-Mid September
- Concord grapes have large seeds and are highly aromatic
- Self pollinating .you may still want to plant pollinating partners to increase the size of your crops
- Mature Height: 8-10'

<u>Blueberries—Berkeley</u>



- It is a highbush blueberry, with berries ready for harvest in late July through August
- Plants are also known for their hardiness and disease resistance
- Self pollinating, you may still want to plant pollinating partners to increase the size of your crops
- Mature Height: 5-8'

Deer Plot Mix

Consists of hand picked species.

Best time to plant is in July.

Recommended steps to establish mix:

- Test the soil.
- Kill the weeds in the food plot.
- Loosen the soil if severely compacted with a tiller or disc.
- Lime and fertilize as recommended by the soil test.
- Plant seed mix at recommended planting rate.
- Broadcast seed evenly and rake or drag seed into top 1/4" of the soil surface.
