## NORWAY SPRUCE



- One of the best conifers for shelter and windbreaks.
- Branches grow densely into one another.
- Dense, dark green needles.
- Fast growth of 75 to 80 feet tall and 35 to 40 feet wide.

## EASTERN WHITE PINE



- Hardy and fast growing.
- Needles are soft, light green-blue and 4 inches long.
- Excellent ornamental tree for windbreak or dense screen.
- Up to 100 feet tall and 40 feet wide.

# AMERICAN PERSIMMON



- Grown for its beautiful foliage, edible fruit and wood density.
- White, fragrant flowers are very sweet and favorable to honeybees.
- Fruit is orange- yellow, sweet and edible once ripe after a hard freeze.

# WHITE OAK



- Yields acorns up to 1".
- Does best in full sun.
- Great fall color with flashes of red and burgundy.
- Reaches mature height of 40-100 feet.

## TULIP POPLAR



- Also known as Yellow Poplar or Tuliptree.
- It is a fast growing species.
- Leaves are shaped like tulip flowers.
- 1.5- 2" yellow flowers can be seen in the tree top.

## SUGAR MAPLE



- Brilliant fall colors of yellow, orange, and red.
- It is the primary producer for maple syrup.
- Also called Rock maple or Hard maple. It is great for timber.

## CHINESE CHESTNUT



- Grows into a majestic tree up to 60' tall and wide.
- This variety is resistant to the chestnut blight, heat and humidity.
- Prefers full sun to partial shade, moist well drained soil.

## EASTERN REDBUD



- Beautiful pink flowers in spring
- Seed pods replace the flowers and remain hanging all winter.
- Features 3-5" heart shaped leaves that turn bright yellow during fall.
- Mature height of 20-30 feet.

# COMMON PEAR



- At full maturity it spans 40-50 feet tall.
- This variety lives 50 to 75 years.
- Grows well in moist soils.
- Flowers are a popular food source for bees.

## WINTERBERRY HOLLY



- Beautiful fall and winter color.
- Female plants produce bright red berries for fall and winter, attracting winter song birds.
- Plant at least five together for best pollination.
- Mature Height of 6-12 feet.

## BLACK ELDERBERRY



- This shrub is 6.5-13 feet tall.
- The flowers are used to make wine and fruits are used to make pies, jams, and preserves.
- Renowned for their medicinal purposes.

## AVALON NECTARINE



- Early season nectarine.
- Has a firm and balanced flavor.
- A vigorous tree with low susceptibility to bacterial leaf spot.

- A crisp, juicy, sweet-tart apple making it #1 in taste panels.

Recommended steps to establish mix:

*Best time to plant is in July.*

- Test the soil.
- Kill the weeds in the food plot.
- Loosen the soil if severely compacted (tiller/disc)
- Lime and fertilize as recommended by the soil test.
- Plant seed mix at recommended planting rate.
- Broadcast seed evenly and rake or drag seed into top 1/4" of the soil surface.


