The approval of an amendment to the agreement between Snyder County and iSolved for calendar years 2026–2028, providing for a 3% annual fee increase in lieu of the standard 5.78% increase

The approval of the engagement letter with Herring, Roll & Solomon, P.C. for audit services for the Snyder County Tax Collectors for the year ended December 31, 2025, at a cost of \$650 per tax collector for a total cost of \$13,650.00

The approval of the experiential education agreement between Susquehanna University and Snyder County for the Amplify internship program for the term of August 31, 2026 through December 17, 2026

The approval of the inmate housing agreement between Snyder County and Mifflin County for the housing of Snyder County inmates at the Mifflin County Correctional Facility at a daily rate of \$75 per inmate, with an additional \$5 per day for segregated inmates, effective March 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, with provisions for annual renewal

The approval of the commercial lease agreement between Snyder County and Justice Works YouthCare for Suite #75 (178 sq. ft.) located at 713 Bridge Street, Selinsgrove, PA, for the term November 1, 2025 through October 31, 2026, at a monthly rent of \$213.01, with provisions for automatic annual renewal unless terminated with 60 days' written notice

The ratification of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Agreement (HMGP) for Federal Fiscal Year 2021 between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (PEMA) and Snyder County, providing up to \$8,448.75 in funding and extending the period of performance through August 5, 2026

Discussion and possible approval of the purchase of Tasers and related equipment through Axon Enterprises, Inc. utilizing JRI-2 grant funding for Probation and Parole, including initial county funding with anticipated full reimbursement, to replace existing Tasers that are outdated or non-functioning

The approval to purchase bulletproof vests and related equipment for County Corrections at a cost of \$1,817.92, and authorization to seek up to 50% reimbursement through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance's Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program
