

June Rain Barrel Workshop Held by SCCD

The Snyder County Conservation District (SCCD) held two rain barrel workshops on June 24, 2026. Roughly thirty (30) representing twenty-five (25) households attended. Each household received a complete assembled rain barrel at the conclusion of the workshop.
